National Institute of Public Health Training & Research, Mumbai, a Central Training Institute of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India announces Masters of Public Health (MPH) (to be affiliated with MUHS, Nashik) and Post Graduate diploma in Hospital Management (PGDHM) (affiliated to International Institute for Population Sciences, Mumbai) in academic year 2021-22. NIPHTR has been conducting Govt. of India recognized two Regular courses for in-service sponsored candidates e.g., **i) Diploma course in Health Promotion Education (DHPE) and ii) Post Graduate Diploma course in Community Health Care (PGDCHC)** for several years. Both are residential training courses, affiliated to International Institute for Population Sciences, Mumbai, a Deemed University under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare. 1. Applications are to be submitted in a prescribed application form (available on NIPHTR

Website -www.fwtrc.gov.in) along with application fees of 200/- (No fees for SC/ST Candidates) through online mode or in the form of DD/Bankers cheque drawn in favour of “**Director, National Institute of Public Health Training & Research**” payable at Mumbai by Reg/ speed post only.

2. Candidates Belonging to SC/ST categories will be given relaxation in age as per government norms.
3. Field visit charges towards return journey by train/air, lodging & boarding charges to be borne by candidates separately.
4. SC/ST candidates are exempted from Tuition fees for Skill Based Training Courses. 5. Selection of the candidates will be by selection committee constituted by NIPHTR, Mumbai.
6. Accommodation will not be provided by NIPHTR, Mumbai to students of Skill based Training Programmes.
7. Boarding & lodging facilities will be provided by this institute to in-service sponsored candidates undergoing DHPE & PGDCHC course at Panvel Campus on payment as per scheduled rate for residential courses.
8. Hostel charges @ Rs. 500/- per month and mess charges as per actuals will be applicable for residential courses.
9. Last date for submission of application for all courses is **31st March 2021**. 10. NIPHTR, Mumbai reserve rights to incorporate changes in course content, duration, fees, number of seats & may cancel the proposed schedule dates without assigning any reason & without notice.
