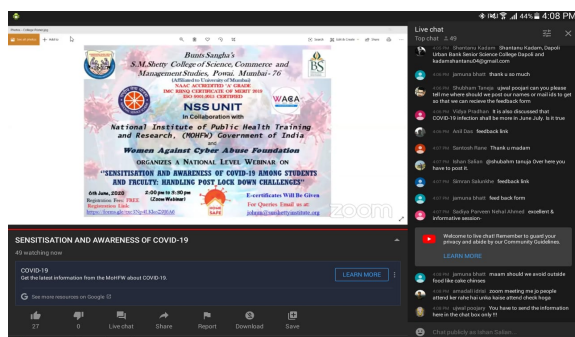


## Webinar
